

MUMPS



There is an increasing number of cases of mumps among 16 to 25 year olds in Kent and Medway as well as nationally.

It is largely among young people who are too old to have been offered MMR vaccines and who are therefore not fully protected against the disease. The Kent Health Protection Unit has decided to approach this situation proactively, and is running an immunisation campaign across Kent in a series of open sessions.
